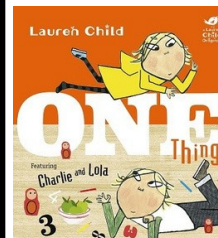

And just a reminder that we do ask people not to cycle in the school grounds as there are a lot of little children who may get knocked into. Thank you for your cooperation with this.

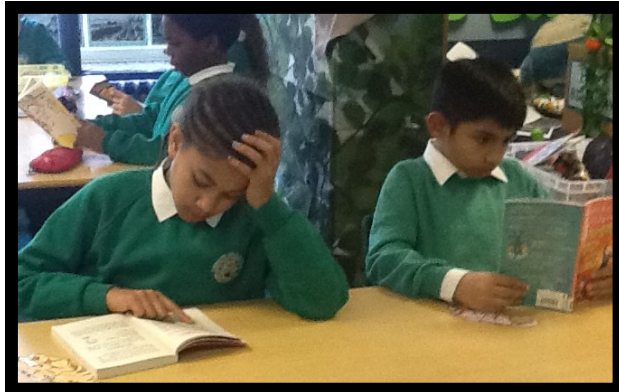
