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School Priorities – September 2023

- **Teaching and Learning** – To have good subject knowledge and understanding of a new high quality curriculum. To support pupils with SEND to build on their learning (including in the specially resourced provision).
- **Behaviour** – To use the behaviour policy consistently and address any low level behaviour. Aim for very high pupil attendance.
- **Personal Development** – To ensure high quality PSHE lessons throughout the school - embed Scheme of work.
- **Leadership and Management** – To develop new middle leaders, encourage CPD, allow for smooth transitions and ensure a high quality curriculum is embedded.
- **EYFS** – To support children's learning, communication and language development, including storytelling, role play and modelling – secure subject knowledge and identify any misconceptions. To build on the EYFS curriculum and outdoor play areas.
