

**Concept: Identity**

Essential question: Where do we come from?

In science, children will learn about materials and their properties.

In RE, children will delve into Judaism, exploring Hanukkah's traditions and the faith's prism. They will ponder if this celebration strengthens the Jewish connection to God.

In Art, children will explore self – portraits and study various artists techniques.

In English we will be reading the following texts: Julian is a Mermaid-Jessica Love. Iggy Peck, Architect by Andrea Beatty and David Roberts. Naughty Bus – Jan Oke. We will say out loud what they are going write about. Children will write a single sentence demarcated with capital letters and full stops. Segment and represent these by graphemes. Children will begin to spell some common exceptions words. Children begin to form lower-case letters in the correct direction, starting and finishing in the right place.

In PSHE, children will learn and discuss classroom rules, what makes the class a safe place, how they feel when they achieve something.

In computing, children will learn about ICT around us and the importance it has.

In PE, children will play different ball games.
